MEMORANDUM

7-1-40

Dear President Clark:

President Wilford A. Beesley of the Salt Lake Stake has requested that we present the following matter to your attention:

Under the General Welfare Program, the Salt Lake Stake has been assigned as their assessment for this year 40,000 pounds of pork. In October of 1939 the project was started with 8 brood sows. These have now increased to nearly 250 pigs.

The Salt Lake Stake has been successful in obtaining the garbage from the L. D. S. Hospital and a few other minor establishments. This, however, is not sufficient

Gladys Earl J. called for an appt which I gave him for Tuesday.

Bennett Harold. Telephoned and had his come on and Gladys before him. He thought about a food insurance program. He seemed thoroughly sure it: I asked him to think on the replacement element of food.

Widder Jack. Telephoned about Mrs Peterson and poultry people at A.C. - they would be there.

Adams Orval. Telephoned about Donohue coming to see me and Jim.
Morris Ted J. asked whether the First Presidency or the J.S. should give out about coalescence - asked D.D.M. and was agreed First Presidency shd. do it.

Dwyer Father. Writing dissertation for Catholic Univ of Am - Bp. Hunt spoke to me about him the other day. He wishes access to our library. I took him up and introduced him to Jrs. Fielding Hunt and Dwyer both said he would not abuse our country.
Wheeler (FBI) came in (ostensibly at least) about Walter Eldredge Grant Jr. - who is an applicant for position in FBI. The Father came to see me the other day. I said what I could and called in Joseph Anderson who also gave information.

Ashten (Raymond J) and Jensen (Christian O) - came in with me for possible lunch to meet some planner who is here.

Donohue - Mr. (Dr?) Came in pursuant to telephone from Orval Adams - Came to tell me he had received word from very secret source that FBI people knew some of our German members were Hitlerites - Hitler spies. I explained our situation; the report of our members; spoke of the foreign language meeting; the false reports that were around about arrests e.g. Bp. Felzer; told him from my conference talk in October last (Germans or ~~Pro~~ Britons); our effort to keep our people (Germans) in line. etc. (I do not know why Donohue came).

Watkins A.W. Came in to make an appointment for a group of his stake who wanted to see us. He afterwards tried to show how well of his heart was in welfare work. Explained peculiarities of berry and fruit growers.
