

# TERRITORY OF UTAH,

Eli H. Murray, Governor of the Territory of Utah,  
**TO HIS EXCELLENCY**, the Governor of the Territory of New Mexico

IT APPEARING TO ME, That one Isaac C. Haight  
stands charged with the crime, of Murder  
committed in the County of Washington Territory of Utah, (as evidence of which a  
certified copy of the indictment found against said  
Isaac C. Haight; the warrant for his arrest, and  
the affidavit of E. J. Sprague, is  
hereunto attached); and which indictment, warrant and affidavit, are hereby  
certified to be authentic. And it also appearing that the said Isaac C. Haight  
has fled the Territory of Utah, and is believed to be within the  
limits of the Territory of New Mexico

**Now, Therefore**, in the name and by the authority of the People of the Territory of  
Utah, and in virtue of the rights and privileges secured and guaranteed by the Laws and Con-  
stitution of the United States, I do hereby demand and require of His Excellency, the Governor of  
the Territory of New Mexico that he cause the said Isaac C. Haight  
to be surrendered and delivered up to the justice of the  
Territory from which he has fled, if to be found within the jurisdiction of the Territory of  
New Mexico.

And I have appointed, and do by these presents constitute and appoint James  
Abac Carthy as the Agent of the Territory of Utah, to receive and convey  
back the said fugitive, to be delivered into the custody of the United States  
Marshal without expense to the Territory of Utah.
